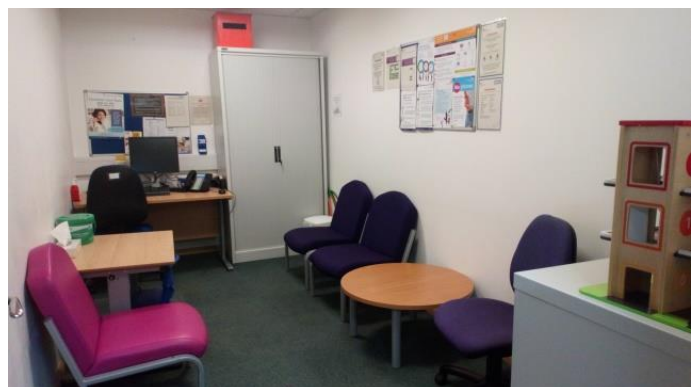

You will be seen in a room like one of these:



You will get to do games and have a bit of a chat with the person you came with (often your mum), for about 15 minutes.

The doctor and therapist will watch from across the room and might video record it too.

They will be wearing face masks – they might look a bit funny, but you can just ignore them and enjoy playing games and chatting with mum.

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After that, you and your parent/carer can wait in this room while the doctor and therapist talk together in a different room.

We can't provide any toys so you will need to bring something along, like a book, tablet or small toy, so you don't get bored waiting. Maybe bring a snack and drink too.



Then the doctor and therapist will come back in to talk to your parent/carer and you.

The doctor might do some simple checks, like measure and weigh you or get you to walk a few steps.

Once you and your parent/carer have spoken to the Doctor it will be time to go home or back to school.
