Subscriptions update

As the year ends, we have reviewed the usage of electronic resources. We have had to cancel some titles and have added a few more resources in order to bring value for money to the Trust. The notable changes are as follows:

Titles or resources cancelled:

- UpToDate (Following consultation with Directors, it was decided to extend the subscription to UpToDate until the end of December 2024)

UpToDate Availability - Notification of Changes

The current three-year contract with Wolters Kluwer, providers of UpToDate clinical decision support tool, had been due to expire at the end of December. We have negotiated for an additional year extension to the contract, thus access will continue until the end of December 2024.

You may have received notifications directly from Wolters Kluwer or UpToDate advising you to download your CME credits. Please ignore that instruction as it was the supplier's marketing approach.


Meanwhile, the Knowledge and Library Services are promoting alternative clinical decision support tools. NHS England have made BMJ Best Practice available nationally. BMJ Best Practice have improved significantly since 2020 and now includes a comorbidities management tool, patient

information, calculators, videos and is more relevant to the UK setting on drug recommendations. Since August 2022, both UpToDate and BMJ Best Practice have demonstrated high usage.


Clinicians are encouraged to try the following alternative sources or tools that are easily available:

- Medscape (register an individual account free)


Usage comparison based on topic views:




Our libraries are accessible 24/7 over the whole Christmas period – simply access with your Trust swipecard.
