## Renewal of ESHT OpenAthens accounts

From 28<sup>th</sup> November, all ESHT OpenAthens accounts have needed to be renewed. That's because we're making a change to the data that is sent to our content providers via OpenAthens, as some providers now require your email address for you to benefit from the full functionality of their platforms (providers won't be using this to send you marketing materials). We have therefore updated our [privacy notice](#) which explains what we do with your data.

If you have an OpenAthens account and have not yet accepted the new privacy notice, please follow these instructions to renew. The process should only take a couple of minutes:

- Go to <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/Renewal>
- Login with your account details
- Tick the box to say you have read and accept the T&Cs and the privacy notice
- Then click on the renew button
- Verify your email address

You will then be able to carry on accessing our full range of resources, including journals, e-books and databases.
