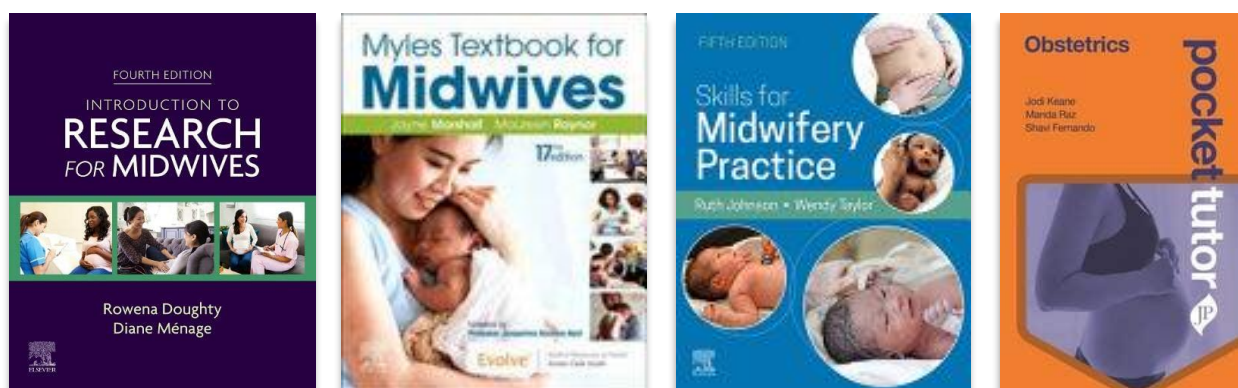

### New Resources for Midwives



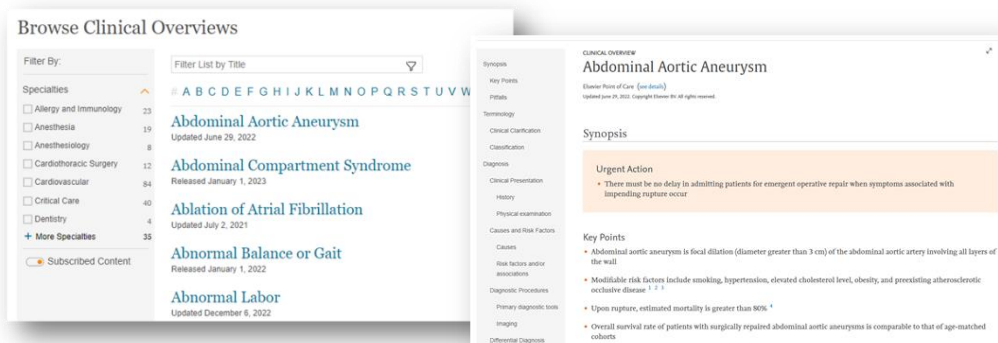

**ClinicalKey** is an evidence-based clinical decision support tool which can be accessed at [www.clinicalkey.com](http://www.clinicalkey.com) (log in via OpenAthens) or via the mobile app. Key features include:

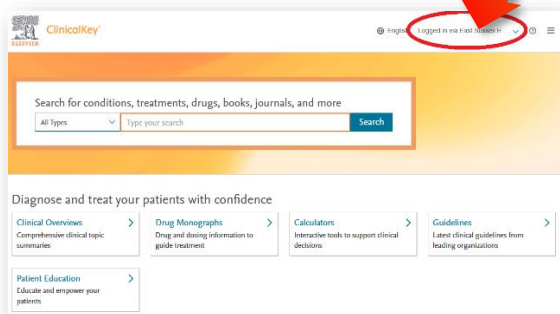
- over 1,000 medical and surgical e-books (filter by specialty)
- over 500 medical and surgical e-journals (filter by specialty - view full text articles)
- clinical overviews – search for best practice for an emerging illness
- a range of clinical images and procedural videos



Filter books and journals by specialty. Some books such as [The Eye: Basic Sciences in Practice](#) and [Sabiston Textbook of Surgery](#) have accompanying videos.
