ClinicalKey®

ClinicalKey is an evidence-based clinical decision support tool which can be accessed at www.clinicalkey.com (log in via OpenAthens) or via the mobile app. Key features include:


- over 1,000 medical and surgical e-books (filter by specialty)
- over 500 medical and surgical e-journals (filter by specialty view full text articles)
- clinical overviews search for best practice for an emerging illness
- a range of clinical images and procedural videos



Filter books and journals by specialty. Some books such as <u>The Eye: Basic Sciences in Practice</u> and <u>Sabiston Textbook of Surgery</u> have accompanying videos.

- download the Clinical Key mobile app on your tablet or mobile phone
- download book chapters in PDF format
- · get access to the presentation maker
