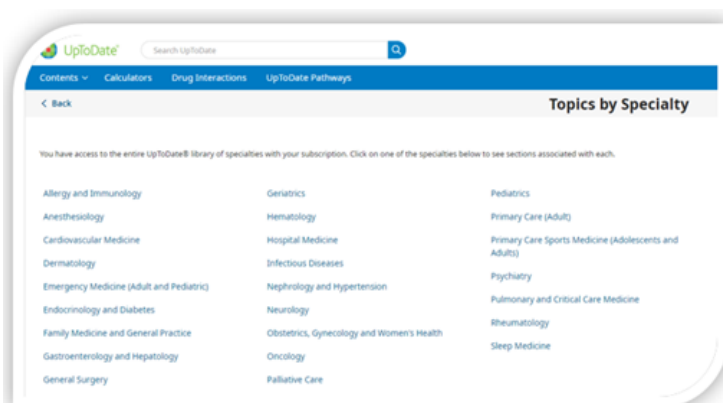
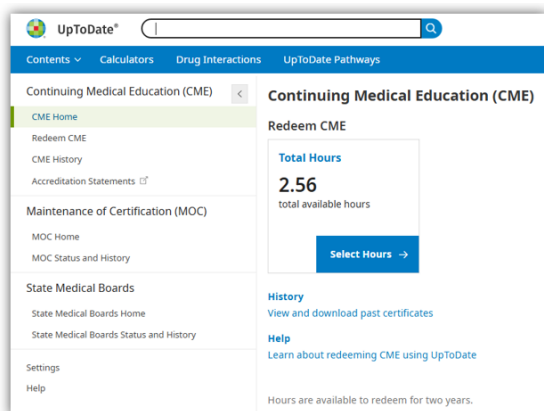
Resource of the Month



[UpToDate](#) is a clinical decision support tool: it provides evidence-based clinical information at the point-of-care. The resource offers current, evidence-based and graded clinical recommendations. The key features include:

- topic summaries and recommendations for treatment
- differential diagnosis
- drug interactions tool
- graphics and tables
- calculators
- patient information

View clinical topic summaries by specialty: a valuable resource when refreshing your knowledge or starting a new rotation.



Access UpToDate via the [Extranet](#) (no login required) or online at www.uptodate.com (sign in via OpenAthens - [register](#) for an OpenAthens account if you don't have one). If you sign in via OpenAthens, you can download the mobile app, and, you can accrue Continuing Medical Education (CME/CPD) credit - useful for re-validation.

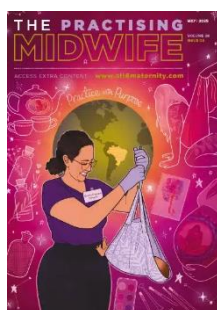
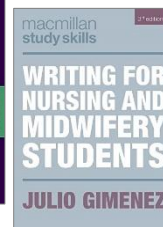
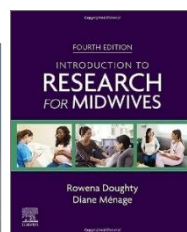
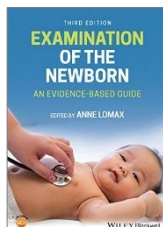
As we celebrate **International Day of the Midwife** and **Nurses' Day** in May, our libraries have a huge array of resources to explore.
