

Medical Photography For Orthodontics

Why have photographs been requested

Your Orthodontist has referred you to the Medical Photography department. Photographs are taken as part of your treatment process for these important reasons:

- Treatment Planning
- Progress Monitoring
- Before and After Comparisons

What happens during an appointment

Appointments last approximately 20 minutes.

The photographs include standardised views of your head and intra-oral pictures of your teeth, using lip retractors and a small mirror.



Photography Appointment Booking

****Medical Photography appointments are not affected by Orthodontic cancellations****

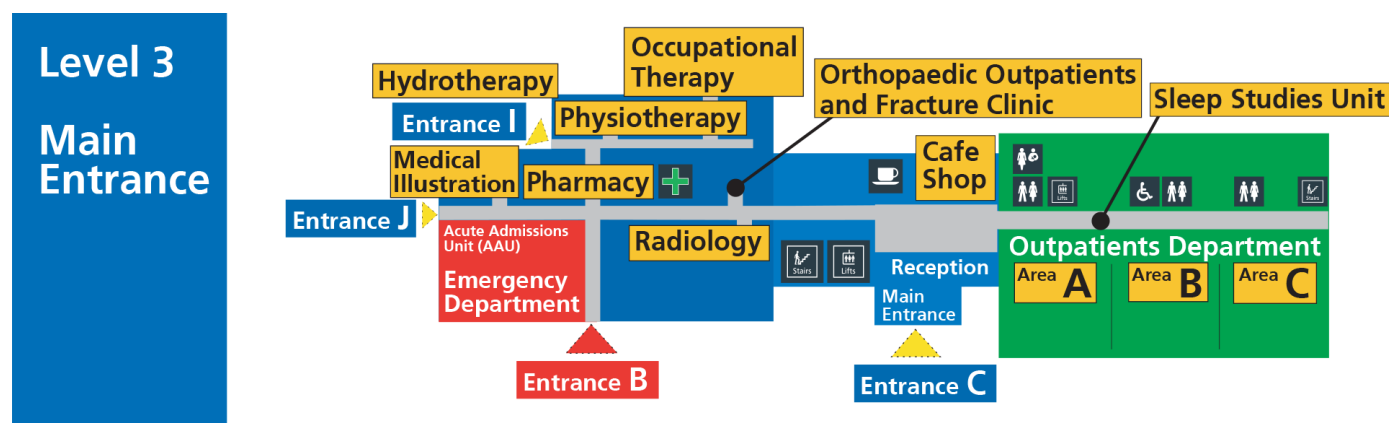
Directions to Medical Photography, Conquest Hospital

Enter the hospital through the Main Entrance on Level 3.

Turn left and walk along the blue zone corridor.

Medical Illustration is located towards the end of the corridor on the right hand side.

Press the buzzer and a photographer will meet you.

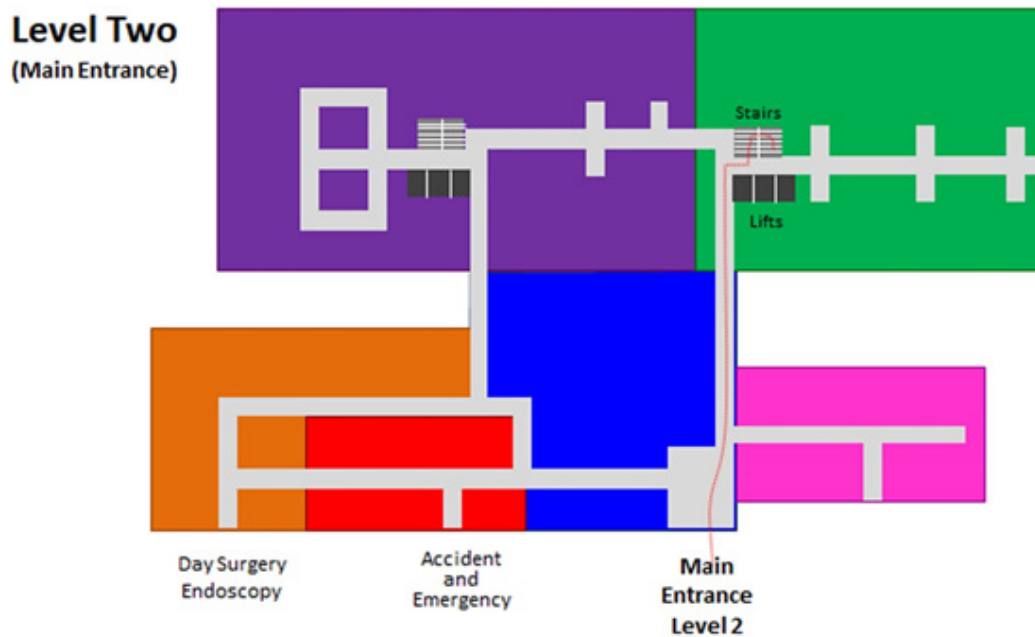


Directions to Medical Photography, Eastbourne DGH

Enter the hospital through the Main Entrance on Level 2.

Proceed straight ahead along the corridor towards the end.

Take the stairs or lift down to Level 1 (the lower ground floor).



Head towards the Purple Zone (turning right at the bottom of the stairs, or left, if coming from the lift).

Follow signs for 'Medical Photography'.

Medical Photography is off a short corridor on the right, opposite the Discharge Lounge.

Please ring the bell on arrival and take a seat.
