Resource of the Month



<u>ClinicalSkills.net</u> is an online resource which displays 100s of clinical skills procedures. The step-by-step guides are user-friendly and highly illustrated; most are 2 to 5 pages long. They range from simple procedures (e.g. washing a person's hair in bed) to the more complex (e.g. cannulation).



ClinicalSkills.net:


- provides clear visual information on clinical skills
- is regularly updated
- is evidence based
- links to national guidance and journal articles



You can even utilise it to record your CPD which you can use as evidence towards your revalidation!

Library membership is open to all Trust staff, including students on placement.




Events
