FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

1) a) What are you currently using to manage patient flow at the Trust (manage the patient journey from entry to discharge)?

Nervecentre.

b) What is the contract end date of the above system?

31st March 2024.

c) What was the contract value for the above system?

Whilst the Trust holds the information requested, it is applying a Section 43(2) exemption in relation to this part of the request as the release of the information is likely to prejudice its commercial interests.

In applying the exemption consideration has been given to the public interest in enabling scrutiny of public sector decision making and the general public interest in accountability and transparency.

We have concluded that by providing the contract value could cause harm to the Trust as this could distort the market-place and therefore, result in the Trust not obtaining best value for money.

In this instance, we consider that the public interest in withholding the information is greater than the public interest in disclosing the information.

d) Are you planning on going out to tender, or review alternative systems within the next 12 months?

The Trust are going out to tender in the next 12 months as part of the Electronic Patient Record (EPR) programme, this will cover a wider remit than what Nervecentre currently provides us with.

2) a) Are you currently using an electronic bed management system at the Trust?

Nervecentre.

b) What is the contract end date of the above system?

31st March 2024.

c) What was the contract value for the above system?

Whilst the Trust holds the information requested, it is applying a Section 43(2) exemption in relation to this part of the request as the release of the information is likely to prejudice its commercial interests.

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d) Are you planning on going out to tender, or review alternative systems within the next 12 months?

The Trust are going out to tender in the next 12 months as part of the Electronic Patient Record (EPR) programme, this will cover a wider remit than what Nervecentre currently provides us with.
