I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

I am writing to request information related to the organisation's gas and electricity contracts, as well as details on the energy management system.

Note – Total Energies Gas & Power has been the gas supplier since April 2022, prior to this it was Corona Energy and so answers provided to later questions will relate to the prevailing supplier at the time.

Suppliers are determined at framework agreement level, and our contract commitment is effectively in relation to the latter. It is an evergreen contractual arrangement, always with a notice of 2.5 years should we decide to terminate.
