lassets integrates with e-Quip.

Health Edge SSD – links to Belimed washer software and Wassenburg Endo washers software – process manager.

Omnicell – Pharmacy Stock management system, PAS system.

10. What primary benefits has the Trust observed with the current IMS (e.g., cost savings, efficiency gains, regulatory compliance)?

lassets – enables asset tracking / e-Quip essential for full equipment management lifecycle, maintenance scheduling and equipment replacement programmes.

Health Edge SSD - effective management and tracking of instrumentation, assurance that processes are being followed correctly and meet regulatory compliance.

Omnicell – Improved stock control and medicines waste, reduced nursing and pharmacy time dealing with stock.

11. Do you believe that you are receiving/expect to have received by the contract end good return on investment from this IMS?

lassets and e-quip are essential tools for equipment management and offer VFM.

Health Edge SSD – yes as this system helps us to reduce instrument loss or misplacement, automates manual processes, monitors sterilisation patterns electronically, allows support for patient safety as provides traceable sterilisation. Also we use the stock system and links to pricing.

Omnicell - Yes.

12. What are the main challenges or limitations experienced with the system?

lassets – limitations are simply down to trust passive infrastructure limitations.

e-Quip – highly flexible tool which is highly customisable by users.

Health Edge SSD – would like to have system in Theatres and Endo to complete full cycle for tracking.

Omnicell – inability to expand systems as required throughout Trust.

13. Does the Trust have plans to upgrade or replace the IMS within the next three years?

14. What new capabilities/improvements/features would be a priority in future IMS procurement (e.g., enhanced traceability, asset or human tissue tracking)?

lassets / e-Quip – future development is to develop a 2 way real time asset location transfer between the 2 systems which is currently being worked on.

Health Edge SSD – Include all software updates and validation in contract cost over contract term. – to include RFID capability moving forward.

Omnicell – Advanced reporting capabilities, electronic Controlled Drug Registers and Emergency Cupboards, use of barcodes.
