I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

1. The total number of beds in all the hospitals and wards under your trust or foundation.

Conquest Hospital	357 Beds
Eastbourne District General Hospital	355 Beds
Rye Memorial Hospital	19 Beds
Bexhill Hospital	57 Beds

Total - 788 Beds across acute and community bed base.

2. Total number of patients who were 'medically fit for discharge' (MFFD) or no longer meet the criteria to reside as mentioned in the latest NHS England data, but remained in hospital for seven days or longer between 1 January 2024 and 1 January 2025 because they had no recourse to public funds (NRPF) as highlighted here.
