### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

# 1. In the fiscal year 2024 / 2025 how much money has the trust spent recompensing patients for lost or stolen property?

£32,276.

### 2. How does the trust dispose of unclaimed lost property?

Wherever possible, property is returned to the patient or family. Any unclaimed items considered to be of negligible value e.g., clothes are disposed of via general waste.

Items of value are sent to Auction.

Items with data are sent to digital for data removal / disposing of.

## 3. What value or threshold (£GBP) does a ward or department have to settle with a patient directly, rather than escalating to the Finance department?

There is no threshold.

All claims for lost/damaged property are approved by the budget holder and passed to finance for payment.

If the claim is high, Finance checks the reason for the payment and any corresponding invoices / quotations that back up the claim before the claim is paid out. If for any reason Finance are not happy with the request, more information is requested.
