## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

## I'm writing to request information about complaints submitted by the midwives, nurses and doctors working at your trust.

From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023 up to and including 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025, can you please tell me the following:

- 1) The number of grievances submitted by midwives, broken down into the nature of the complaint, including but not limited to:
  - a) Bullying and harassment.
  - b) Work relations.
  - c) Terms and conditions of employment.
  - d) Health and safety.
  - Please break this down by year and month.
  - For "bullying and harassment" and "work relations" (above) please provide us with the Trust's summary of each grievance submitted by midwives and, where relevant, the outcome. Where necessary, please remove identifying details.

Section 17 Notice of Refusal – Sections 38(1) and 40(2) applied.

The information you have requested is exempt under section 38(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to:

- (a) endanger the physical or mental health of any individual, or
- (b) endanger the safety of any individual.

We have concluded that due to the low numbers, disclosure could have a detrimental effect on an individual's staff mental health and wellbeing.

In this instance, we consider that the public interest in withholding the information is greater than the public interest in disclosing the information.

I can confirm that we hold this information, but it is exempt under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Personal Information of third parties. This is because this information may allow the identification of individual staff members due to the small number and disclosure would breach the principles of the Data Protection Act.

This is an absolute exemption and there is, therefore, no requirement to consider the public interest.
