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I am responding to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. The answers to your specific questions are as follows:

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

1) What technology platform does the Trust currently use to support its Direct Engagement (DE) model for the medical locum workforce?

2) What is the name of the platform provider?

Liaison.

3) What is the cost of the platform expressed as a percentage fee or pence per hour?

Section 17 Notice of Refusal – Section 43(2) applied, please see below:

Whilst the Trust holds the information requested, in respect of the cost of the platform expressed as a percentage fee or pence per hour, it is applying a Section 43(2) exemption in relation to this part of the request as the release of the information is likely to prejudice its commercial interests.

In applying the exemption consideration has been given to the public interest in enabling scrutiny of public sector decision making and the general public interest in accountability and transparency.

We have concluded that sharing commercials could disadvantage the incumbent supplier against their competitors. The information could provide competitors with the suppliers pricing, which could result in these suppliers obtaining a competitive advantage which could result in the Trust not obtaining best value for money. It could also result in increased charges across the NHS.

In this instance, we consider that the public interest in withholding the information is greater than the public interest in disclosing the information.

4) What staffing groups does the Trust include in its Direct Engagement (DE) model (e.g., medical, AHPs, clinical, non-clinical)?

Medical, AHP and HSS.

5) What is the current uptake of the DE model within the Trust, specifically as a percentage or proportion of the total locum workforce?

100% DE.
