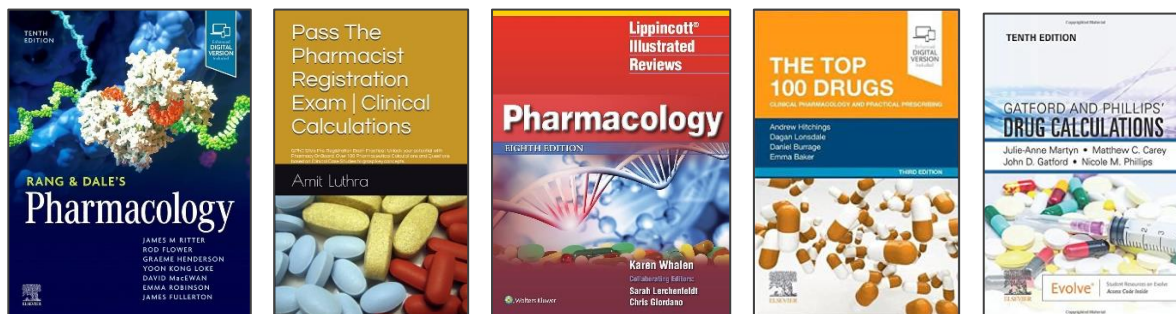
We also welcome more general requests such as how to set up an OpenAthens account, use our e-books or Browzine or anything else research related.

World Pharmacists Day // 25th September

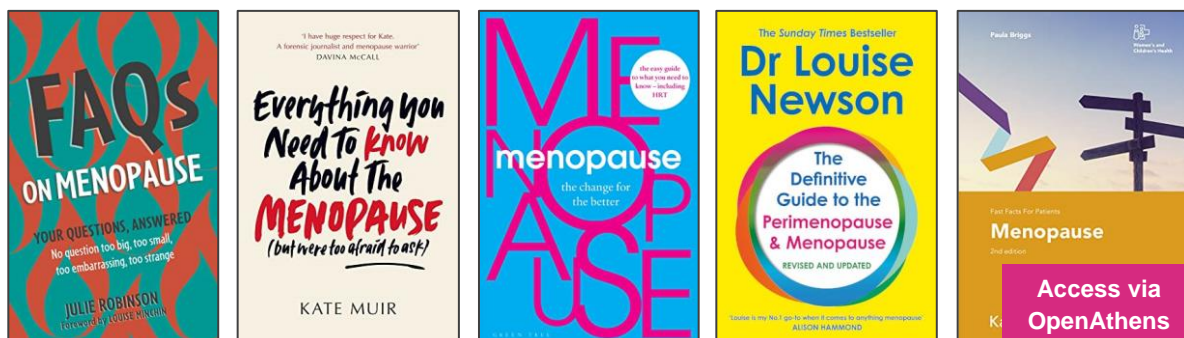
World Pharmacists Day is observed on 25th September each year to recognise pharmacists for the role they play in improving global health by providing easily accessible care and advice.
